STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Staff”) and for its recommendation states:

1. On June 28, June 29 and July 2, 2012, the above-referenced incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies and the ILEC-affiliated competitive local exchange telecommunications companies Chariton Valley Telecom Corporation, Mark Twain Communications Company, and Green Hills Telecommunications Services (“the Companies”) issued tariff revisions that will alter their state access tariff provisions regarding intrastate Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) traffic. Those tariff revisions carry a thirty-day effective date. However, along with its tariff revision, the Companies filed a motion asking the Commission to approve the tariff revisions on an expedited basis so that the tariffs can go into effect on July 13, 2012.

2. The Staff recommends that the tariffs be approved without suspension or further proceedings in this matter. The Staff has reviewed the proposed tariffs (see the attached Memorandum) and has no objection to their approval on an expedited basis.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission approve the proposed tariff revisions to become effective on or before July 13, 2012.

Subject: Staff Recommendations to Approve Expedited Treatment and Revised Tariff Filings to Comply with the FCC's April 25, 2012 Second Order of Reconsideration, WC Docket No. 10-90, which permits companies to continue to apply intrastate originating switched access rates to originating Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol Telecommunications Traffic until June 30, 2014.

Date: July 02, 2012

On November 18, 2011, The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued its USF/ICC Transformation Order which required all local exchange carriers (LECs) to file new state access tariff provisions to address intrastate Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol (I-VoIP) telecommunications traffic. The above telecommunications companies have made the necessary tariff filings which are in effect.

On April 25, 2012, the FCC issued its Second Order of Reconsideration which modified the compensation of originating I-VoIP - Public Switched Telephone Network (PSTN) traffic on a prospective basis. Intrastate access rates shall apply to intrastate, originating I-VoIP/PSTN traffic on a prospective basis (beginning July 13, 2012) for an interim period ending June 30, 2014. The Second Order was not published in the Federal Register until May 29, 2012. According to the above named companies, the companies acted as soon as possible to file the pleadings. The companies request action as soon as possible, and no later than July 13, 2012, in order to allow an order granting expedited approval to become effective. Amending the tariffs with less than 30 days notice will make the tariffs consistent with federal law and the federally-prescribed rate. This action will not have any negative effect on the access-paying customers, and will avoid having an incorrect rate for intrastate originating VoIP traffic in the relevant tariffs.

Staff requests the Commission grant expedited treatment and approve the tariffs sheets to go in effect on July 13, 2012. Staff has examined the relative annual filings with the Commission and Staff notes none of the Companies are delinquent in any submittals.
