KANSAS CITY POWER & LIGHT COMPANY'S AND KCP&L GREATER MISSOURI OPERATIONS COMPANY'S PRELIMINARY RESPONSE TO STAFF'S REQUEST FOR A PUBLIC VERSION OF THE STAFF REPORT

COMES NOW, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO") (collectively known as the "Company") and respectfully submits its Preliminary Response, attached hereto as Appendix A, to the Staff's request for a public version of the *Staff's Construction Audit and Prudence Review Of Iatan Construction Project for Costs Reported As Of June 30, 2010* ("Staff Report") dated November 3, 2010.

1. In filing its Staff Report in this matter, the Staff "designated the entirety of the document to be Highly Confidential since much of the information included in this *Staff Report* is based on or is information Kansas City Power & Light Company, Inc. (KCPL) has designated to be Highly Confidential when KCPL provided the information to the Staff." (Staff Report Cover Pleading, page 1).

2. Staff's cover pleading further states:

Because KCPL has not reviewed the instant *Staff Report* before the Staff is filing it, the Staff is requesting the Commission to issue an Order

directing KCPL/KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) to review the Staff Report and to file with the Commission or submit to the Staff no later than within 45 days of the Commission's Order a version of the Staff Report that in KCPL / GMO's view redacts, or otherwise identifies, all information that KCPL/GMO consider to be either Highly Confidential or Proprietary consistent with the Commission's designation of those terms in 4 CSR 240-2.135. (Paragraph 3).

3. This matter was briefly discussed during the recent Status Conference held on November 4, 2010, at which undersigned counsel indicated the Company intends to meet the forty-five day time-frame for submitting a redacted document as requested by Staff. As a part of those discussions, the Office of the Public Counsel ("OPC") also requested that the Company consider creating a public version of the Executive Summary of the Staff Report on a more expedited basis. (Transcript, Volume 4, pp. 79-81). To the Company's knowledge, no Order has been issued to date by the Commission responsive to the Staff's or OPC's requests. Nevertheless, the Company is hereby complying with OPC's request, and it is filing the entirety of the Executive Summary portion of the Staff Report as a public document, designated Appendix A.
