**MOTION FOR ADDITIONAL TIME TO
RESPOND TO STAFF’S RECOMMENDATION AND
MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE (AmerenUE) and for its Motion for Additional Time to Respond to Staff’s Recommendation and Motion for Expedited Treatment, states as follows:

On November 19, 2009, AmerenUE filed an application seeking authority to manage its nitrogen oxide emission allowances inventory using any and all available trading structures as outlined in the application. The Commission Staff filed its recommendation regarding that application on May 19, 2010 (Staff’s Recommendation).

On May 20, 2010, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond to Staff’s Recommendation to Grant Application with Conditions. This Order directed any party wishing to respond to the Staff’s Recommendation to do so no later than June 1, 2010.

The Staff’s Recommendation is lengthy and contains several sections and subsections that AmerenUE needs additional time to review. AmerenUE would also like some additional time to explore options for settlement of this case with the other parties. Consequently, AmerenUE requests a thirty (30) day extension, until July 1, 2010, to respond to Staff’s Recommendation.
