MOTION FOR WAIVER OF RULE 2.130(8)

COMES NOW the Missouri Department of Economic Development, Division of Energy ("DE") and, pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Rule 4 CSR 240-2.015, respectfully requests a waiver of rule 4 CSR 240-2.130(8). For its Motion, DE states as follows:

1. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.130(8) requires "the prepared testimony of each witness shall be filed separately and shall be accompanied by an affidavit providing the witness's oath."

2. DE's witness in this case, Ms. Jane Epperson, is out-of-state and unavailable to provide an affidavit to accompany her rebuttal testimony at this time. Ms. Epperson will be back in the office on Tuesday, September 4, 2018. DE requests a waiver to permit it to file Ms. Epperson's rebuttal testimony on August 30, 2018 without the affidavit, and to file the affidavit on September 4, 2018, when Ms. Epperson returns.

3. No party will be prejudiced by an order granting this waiver request.

WHEREFORE, the Division of Energy respectfully requests a one-time waiver of Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.130(8) for the reasons set forth above.
