STAFF'S MOTION TO ESTABLISH PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its Motion states:

- 1. On August 22, 2000, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an Order Recognizing Issues And Directing Filing Of Procedural Schedule which, *inter alia*, directed the parties to file a proposed procedural schedule no later than September 1, 2000.
- 2. The parties convened a teleconference at which they agreed to propose the following procedural schedule:

October 2, 2000	SWBT Direct Testimony
	ILEC Direct Testimony
	Other Parties Direct Testimony (Optional)
November 8, 2000	All Parties Rebuttal Testimony
December 11, 2000	All Parties Surrebuttal Testimony
December 20, 2000	List of Issues and Order of Witnesses
January 3, 2001	All Parties Statements of Position
January 10-12, 2001	Hearing



3. This proposal allows both for Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) to explain its Local Plus Service and for the ILEC (Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier) intervenors to explain their issues in the first round of testimony.

WHEREFORE, the Staff, on behalf of the parties, requests the Commission to adopt the above proposed procedural schedule.
