Application Of Union Electric Company For Authorization To Manage Sulfur Dioxide Emission Allowance Inventory

COMES NOW Union Electric Company ("UE"), pursuant to Section 393.190, RSMo,

and requests authorization to manage its sulfur dioxide ("SO₂") emission allowance

("allowances") inventory. In support thereof, UE states:

Union Electric Company, an "electrical corporation" under the laws of the State of 1. Missouri, and a public utility involved in the generation, transmission, distribution and sale of electric energy and power in Missouri and Illinois, is an operating company in the Ameren Corporation system. Ameren Corporation is a registered public utility holding company, which includes UE and Central Illinois Public Service Company ("CIPS") as operating companies, and Ameren Services Company ("Ameren Services") as the services company for the Ameren system. Ameren Services provides various services to the operating companies, including corporate planning, environmental, financial analysis, legal and other services, including those necessary for the management of emission allowances, as discussed below.

3. SO₂ emission allowances were created by the 1990 Amendments to the federal Clean Air Act ("Amendments"). An allowance is an authorization to emit one ton of SO₂, 42 USC 7651a(3). The Amendments allocate allowances to UE each year, based on historical operations at UE's fossil power plants. These allowances are transferable and various public and private markets have developed to facilitate allowance trading.

4. Ameren Services currently forecasts an allowance surplus for UE through at least the year 2007 and most likely much longer. Ameren Services and UE are requesting the flexibility to manage the allowance inventory by utilizing various trading techniques such as allowance forwards, buying and selling allowances, writing allowance options, swapping allowances, loaning allowances and other financial instruments that may be used to earn a return on the inventory. No specific price range is proposed because the market price is subject to rapid change and various allowance mechanisms anticipated to be used have no published price index.

Due to the nature of the allowance market, UE does not deem it advisable to be more specific in this pleading concerning its plans. UE will, however, discuss proposed management strategies with the Staff and work to draft appropriate documents for the Commission's consideration and approval.

5. Ameren Services and UE are not at this time requesting any particular ratemaking or accounting treatment for allowance sales. Pursuant to the Experimental Alternative Regulation Plans approved in Case Nos. ER-95-411 and EM-96-149, "Any sale of emission allowances shall be reflected above-the-line in the ROE calculation." (Attachment C - Reconciliation Procedure) No modification to that procedure is requested here.

WHEREFORE, Union Electric Company respectfully requests an Order of the

Commission authorizing it to manage its SO₂ allowance inventory.
