NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On August 6, 1999, Maverix.com, Inc. (Maverix or Applicant), filed its application requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for the purpose of providing data high speed communications technologies for non-basic, non-switched local exchange services and interexchange services (intraLATA and interLATA). Maverix attached an illustrative tariff to the application.

The Commission notes several deficiencies with the application.

First, Maverix indicates that it is not a 1+/0+ carrier and currently has no plans to offer voice services. However, Maverix did request waiver of various 1+/0+ carrier services, while incongruously stating that the waivers may not be necessary.

Second, Maverix requests that pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo, that the Commission waive the application various rules and statutory provisions. However, Applicant also attached an illustrative tariff which requested a slightly different set of waivers. Applicant does not explain the discrepancy.

Third, although the application requests waiver of Section 4 CSR 240-32.040(2) "Records within the state" (sic), this section actually addresses metering, inspections and tests.

Fourth, it is not clear whether Maverix served a copy of the application on the Office of the Public Counsel as required by Section 386.710.2, RSMo 1994.

No further action will be taken by the Commission on this application until Maverix corrects the deficiencies in its application.

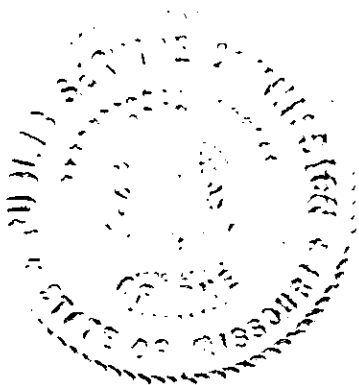
