

NOTICE

AmerenUE has filed revised tariff sheets with the Missouri Public Service Commission (PSC) that would increase the company's electric service revenues by approximately \$250.8 million. For the average residential customer the proposed increase would be approximately \$8.66 per month. AmerenUE's rate filing includes a request to implement a fuel adjustment clause. A fuel adjustment clause, if approved by the Commission, would allow 95% of the net increases or decreases in fuel and purchased power costs less off-system sales revenues occurring after base electric rates are set by the pending electric rate case to be passed through to customers as a separate line on customer's bills. Ninety-five percent of the increases in net fuel and purchased power costs less off-system sales revenues above base electric rates would be applied to customer bills via a separate and additional charge and 95% of the net decreases would be applied to customer bills via a separate credit.
