Address your application to the Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and serve copies on the applicant, the applicant's attorney, and all intervenors. If no one requests intervention or a hearing, the Commission may act upon an application without hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W. 2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). You may obtain a copy of an application for service authority filed with the Commission by sending a written request to the Secretary at the above address.

The Commission's Data Center is directed to send a copy of this Notice of Applications to every telecommunications company that provides basic local exchange service in Missouri.
