COMES NOW, Embarq Missouri, Inc. d/b/a CenturyLink, (“CenturyLink”) and files this Application for Approval of an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement (“Amendment”) between CenturyLink and Time Warner Cable Information Services (Missouri), LLC (“Time Warner”) pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (the “Federal Act”). In support of its Application, CenturyLink states the following:

CenturyLink is a Missouri corporation with offices at 1120 South Tryon Street, Suite 700, Charlotte, NC 28203. CenturyLink is authorized to transact business within the State of Missouri and is authorized by the Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications service within the state.

To CenturyLink’s knowledge, there are no overdue assessments or annual reports or final unsatisfied judgments or decisions against it involving customer service or rates occurring within the last three years.

CenturyLink presents to the Commission the attached Amendment for approval pursuant to the terms of the Federal Act. The implementation of the Amendment complies fully with Section 252(e) of the Act because the Amendment is consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity and does not discriminate against any telecommunications carrier. The

Amendment promotes diversity in providers and increases customer choice for telecommunications services.

III. STANDARD OF REVIEW

The statutory standard of review under Section 252(e) of the Federal Act states:

(e) Approval by State Commission.

(1) Approval Required. – Any interconnection agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission. A State commission to which an agreement is submitted shall approve or reject the agreement with written findings as to any deficiencies.

(2) Grounds For Rejection – The State commission may only reject –

(A) an agreement (or any portion thereof) adopted by negotiation under subsection (a) if it finds that –

(i) the agreement (or portion thereof) discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement; or

(ii) the implementation of such agreement or portion is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity.

IV. REQUEST FOR APPROVAL

CenturyLink seeks the Commission's approval of the Amendment, consistent with the provisions of the Act. The Amendment is bilateral, reached as a result of negotiation and compromise between the parties. There are no outstanding issues involving the limited subject matter of the Amendment that require the assistance of mediation or arbitration. CenturyLink and Time Warner do not believe a docket or intervention by other parties is necessary or appropriate.

CenturyLink requests that the Commission grant expeditious approval of the Amendment, without change, suspension, or other delay in its implementation.
