NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY


On September 29, 1999, Intercontinental Communications Group, Inc., d/b/a Fusion - Trucker Phone (Applicant), filed its application requesting a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri. Applicant also filed its proposed tariff (Tariff File No. 200000287) with an effective date of November 15. In paragraph 14 of its application, Applicant requested that the following rules and statutory provisions be waived as they relate to the regulation of the Applicant:

However, in its proposed tariff, Applicant failed to request waiver of the following rules and statutes that are included in the waiver request of its application: Sections 392.210.2 and 392.300.2, RSMo., and 4 CSR 240-30.060(5)(B).

Applicant's application is inconsistent with its proposed tariff and is, therefore, deficient. Applicant is directed to file, no later than October 25, 1999, either an amended pleading or substitute tariff sheets correcting its request for waiver of statutes and rules so that the application and the proposed tariff are consistent.
