**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME**

On September 21, 2001, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, moved for an extension of time to file its responsive pleading. The Industrial Energy Consumers specifically request an extension of 20 days after it receives Staff's data responses in which to file its responsive pleading.

No party has objected to this motion and under 4 CSR 240-2.080(16), the time for doing so has now passed. Therefore, the motion for an extension of time to file a responsive pleading shall be granted.

1. That the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers is granted an extension of 20 days within which to prepare and file its responsive pleading, not later than October 25, 2001.
