Enclosed for filing on behalf of SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc., please find one (1) original and (1) copy of the following original and revised tariff pages:

Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 3 – Advanced Services Tariff, consisting of Original Title Page and Original Page Numbers 2 through 73;

P.S.C. Mo.-No. 1 – General Tariff, consisting of 1st Revised Sheet 1, 1st Revised Sheet 35, and 1st Revised Sheet 54; and

P.S.C. Mo.-No. 2 – Access Services Tariff, consisting of Table of Contents 1st Revised Sheet 1, and Section 6 1st Revised Sheet 1.

Pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.065(2), Tariff Filings Which Create Cases, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. is requesting that these tariffs become effective in fewer than thirty (30) days (September 28, 2002), and concurrent with this tariff filing, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. is filing a Motion for Expedited Treatment herein.

Essentially, this tariff filing adds a new Missouri P.S.C. Tariff No. 3 for Advanced Services. SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc.'s existing Access Services Tariff and its existing General Tariff are revised to provide that existing service to existing customers under the current tariffs ("Existing Service") will continue. Specifically, customers who on January 1, 2003 are subscribers of Existing Service may continue their Existing Service under the same rates, terms and conditions. As of January 1, 2003, only

specified changes to Existing Service are permitted, but the customer may choose to migrate its Existing Service to frame relay service offered under SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc.'s New Advanced Services. Effective January 1, 2003, Existing Service is no longer available to new customers who on that date are not subscribers of Existing Service. Customers of Existing Service may purchase the New Advanced Services, in addition to retaining the Existing Service as described above.


The rates, terms and conditions for Existing Service to existing customers, as set out in the existing Access Services Tariff and the existing General Tariff, are not changed by this filing. No rates to existing customers are increased and there is no impact on any existing rates.

SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. is proposing New Advanced Services to its customers in other states under the same rates, terms and conditions as those proposed herein. The rationale of this offering is to provide a new, uniform service to SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. customers in each of those states. To provide for a uniform rollout of these services, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. is requesting expedited approval of these tariffs, to be effective September 28, 2002.

MOTION FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

COMES NOW SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. ("SBC-ASI"), pursuant to Missouri Public Service Commission Rules 4 CSR 240-2.065(2) and 4 CSR 240-2.080(17), and for its Motion for Expedited Treatment states as follows:

1. SBC-ASI received its Interexchange and Non-Switched Local Exchange Certificate of Service Authority in Missouri on November 8, 1999, in Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") Case No. TA-2000-260. Pursuant to its Certificate of Service Authority and lawfully approved tariffs, SBC-ASI operates as a competitive telecommunications carrier in Missouri.

2. On September 9, 2002, SBC-ASI filed original and revised tariff pages with the Commission, said tariff pages containing the prescribed thirty (30) day effective date, and advised the Commission that concurrent with the tariff filing, it was filing this Motion for Expedited Treatment and requesting that the tariffs become effective in fewer than thirty days.


3. SBC-ASI requests that the subject tariffs be approved for service rendered on and after September 28, 2002. The benefit that will accrue is that SBC-ASI is proposing new advanced services to its customers in Missouri and other states under the same rates, terms and conditions as those proposed in the subject tariffs, and expedited

approval of these tariffs will provide for a more uniform rollout of these new services. There will be no negative effect on SBC-ASI's customers or the general public, if the Commission acts by the date requested.

4. This pleading was filed as soon as it could have been.

WHEREFORE, SBC Advanced Solutions, Inc. respectfully requests expedited treatment in the approval of its tariffs filed concurrently herewith, and for such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate.


