

## 1.0 Summary

On October 8, 2019, Tenaska terminated its participation in the North Fork Ridge Purchase and Sale Agreement. As of November 5, 2019, Liberty Utilities Co. has acquired Tenaska's interests in the joint venture with Steelhead Missouri Matrix Wind Holdings, LLC as the other Seller under the North Fork Ridge Purchase and Sale Agreement. Liberty Utilities Co. will be working with Tenaska to effectuate an orderly transition of the project.

With regard to project development, on October 31, 2019, Empire as the Transmission Owner, signed the Interim Generator Interconnection Agreement for the project ("IGIA"). The IGIA will now be signed by the wind project company and then the Southwest Power Pool ("SPP"). Tenaska issued a second limited notice to proceed to Mortenson to advance engineering and procurement efforts and maintain schedule, and the Turbine Supply Agreement was amended to account for Vestas' blade substitution. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) held a consultation meeting with the Osage Nation late in September, which provided more clarity on the effort that will be required to satisfy the Osage and the USACE and receive the Section 404 Clean Water Act permit.

## 2.0 Safety

No safety incidents to report at this time. More detailed reports regarding safety will be provided in the future, especially following the commencement of construction activities.

# 3.0 Project Schedule

In an effort to provide more time to meet the Purchaser milestones, on September 30, 2019, Tenaska and Empire executed an amendment to the Purchase and Sale Agreement extending the time frame for achievement of the milestones. Section 10.4 of the Purchase and Sale Agreement was specifically amended to allow Empire or its affiliate to acquire Tenaska's interests in the project and complete the development of the project. With the Section 404 Clean Water Act Permit milestone unachieved, on October 8, 2019, Tenaska terminated its participation in the Purchase and Sale Agreement. As of November 8, 2019, Liberty Utilities Co. acquired Tenaska's interest in Tenaska Missouri Matrix Wind Holdings, LLC and is assuming the risk that Tenaska previously assumed. Contractual milestones achieved during the report period are as follows:

- Empire:
  - o Draft Eagle Conservation Plan October 1
  - Interconnection Agreement ready for execution October 29

One contractual milestone was not achieved by its deadline date during this period – the Section 404 Clean Water Act permit was not received by September 30.

There are no milestone deadlines in the next report period (November 2019). If there are any continuing delays to the Section 404 Clean Water Act permit, the project may require changes to the construction schedule or methods of execution in order to achieve commercial operations on or before December 31, 2020, thereby receiving the full value of Production Tax Credits available to the project. A more detailed schedule analysis will be provided in future reports following commencement of construction activities.

## 4.0 Development Activities

Development activities for the period were focused on permitting – most significantly the Section 404 Clean Water Act permit, which is a precursor to the start of construction. Wildlife conservation permitting efforts and the interconnection agreements were also an area of emphasis because of upcoming and past due deadlines in October.

Empire provided a draft eagle conservation plan (ECP) to the USFWS in April. USFWS returned comments to Liberty in June, and met with the USFWS at its office in Columbia, MO on June 28 to discuss the ECP, as well as the habitat conservation plan. Stantec worked on refining the draft ECP in order to satisfy the final draft ECP milestone. Empire provided the final draft ECP to Tenaska on the milestone deadline of October 1, 2019. Other work related to wildlife conservation included continuation of the 2019 bat monitoring campaign that began on March 1.

As detailed in Progress Report 2, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) began consultation with a number of Native American Nations as required before issuing the Section 404 CWA permit. Substantial comments were received from the Osage Nation in early August, and the Osage requested additional materials for review. Those materials were provided and the Osage spent the remainder of August and most of September reviewing them. The USACE held a conference with the Osage on September 27. The Osage requested the presence of Tenaska and Stantec, who had performed the archaeological survey on behalf of Tenaska. Based on the meeting, it appears that the Osage Nation is not opposed to this project specifically or wind energy in general, but was not satisfied with the survey methods, which were done in accordance with standards set by the Missouri State Historic Preservation Office. At the request of the archaeologist for the USACE, Empire has engaged Stantec to perform that work on an expedited schedule. Approximately thirty field personnel began work on the expanded archaeological survey at North Fork Ridge on October 7 and completed field surveys on October 11. Cataloging and preservation of artifacts and report preparation was completed, and the supplemental report was provided to USACE on October 21. USACE has been clear that no permit will be issue until consultation with the Osage is complete.

The IGIA was received from the SPP by Empire as the interconnecting utility on October 29 and executed by Empire on October 31, 2019. The IGIA will be executed by the wind project company and then returned to SPP for signature.

#### 5.0 Construction Activities

Construction activities during the report period largely consisted of engineering.

The project substation physical and electrical 90% design package was delivered during the report period, as were shop drawings for instrument transformers, capacitor banks and disconnect switches. The final geotechnical report was also delivered on September 5. Empire met with Tenaska, Mortenson and Burns & McDonnell on September 5 to coordinate engineering and construction activities for the new wind farm generation tie line and the new point of interconnection. The generation tie line drawings were issued for construction on October 16.

On October 3, Tenaska issued a second limited notice to proceed (LNTP) to Mortenson to perform design work and procure materials. This engineering and procurement work was originally intended to occur following the Notice to Proceed; however, the Notice to Proceed has not been given due to uncertainty concerning the schedule for receipt of the Section 404 CWA permit. Advancing design of the project and procuring foundation and substation materials under this LNTP was necessary to protect the construction schedule.

On August 16<sup>th</sup>, Vestas notified Tenaska that there is a shortage of molds for blade manufacturing, and in order to maintain schedule they would supplying a different blade for North Fork Ridge than originally specified. The Turbine Supply Agreement was amended in September to replace the turbine power curve reflecting the change in energy production due to the blade substitution. The amendment also reduced the purchase price to negate the economic impact of the 2.3 GWh reduction in annual energy production due to the change.
