NOTICE ACKNOWLEDGING DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION AND CLOSING CASE

On June 17, 1999, JATO Communications Corp. and JATO Operating Corp. (the Applicants) filed a Joint Application to Transfer Assets and Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from JATO Communications Corp. to its subsidiary, JATO Operating Corp. On October 29, 1999, in Case No. TA-2000-141, JATO Operating Corp. was granted certificates of service authority to provide basic local and interexchange telecommunications services.

Despite the activity regarding JATO Operating Corp in Case No. TA-2000-141, nothing was filed in this case after the application other than a Tax Impact Statement filed on July 23. On February 15, 2000, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to File Status Report. That order directed the Staff of the Commission to file a report regarding the status of the application no later than March 16.

On March 3, the Applicants filed a Motion to Dismiss that explained that when JATO Operating Corp. was granted its own certificates in Case No. TA-2000-141, the need for this application was eliminated.

Applicants ask that the Commission dismiss the application and this case.

4 CSR 240-2.116(1) permits an applicant to voluntarily dismiss its application without an order of the Commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered by filing a notice of dismissal with the Commission and serving a copy on all parties. By filing their Motion to Dismiss, the Applicants have dismissed their application. Therefore there is no need for the Commission to rule on the Motion to Dismiss.

Because the application has been dismissed, there is no longer any need for Staff to comply with the Commission's Order Directing Status Report. Furthermore, there is no need for this case to remain open. Therefore, this case may be closed.
