We the undersigned members of the South Walnut Hills Homeowner Association and other neighbors served by WPC, wish to protest the requested rate increase of the WPC Sewer Company by its President Anthony Monsees.

On April 27, 2007, the President of the Company requested an increase of 100% (from \$17.53 to \$35.06 monthly). The PSC approved a 36% increase at that time.

Now, just one year later, Mr. Monsees is requesting another 100% increase - from a monthly rate of \$23.89 to a monthly rate of \$47.78.

The WPC Sewer Company consists of one small treatment plant that provides service to the residents of our association, as well as to some of our neighbors. According to PSC records, there are approximately 67 customers in all.

An observation of the plant does not indicate that any major improvements have been made to the plant. It is difficult to imagine that operating costs have increased 100% in just one year.

We have not been informed of any proposed capital improvements needed at the plant. A call to the office of the Company asking for information only elicits the response, "We need to pay the bills." With any utility, whether it is large or small, it seems appropriate for customers to receive concise information justifying a proposed increase, particularly one of a hundred per cent.

We respectfully request the Public Service Commission to deny the requested increase.

Set out on the following pages is the activities timeline pertaining to the processing of the above-referenced small utility revenue increase request. This timeline assumes that the Staff's investigation of the revenue increase request will result in a conclusion that an increase in the subject utility's operating revenues is needed, that at least the Utility and Staff will reach an agreement regarding the overall resolution of the request without the need for time extensions, and that the request will be resolved without an arbitration process being used or an evidentiary hearing being held. For cases where an arbitration process is going to be used or an evidentiary hearing is going to be held, it is anticipated that a procedural schedule will be set when that becomes known. In such instances, the 9-month and 11-month deadlines will need to be considered in setting the procedural schedule.

The schedule set out in the timeline establishes the Target Due Date for the completion of certain activities needed to process the request in a timely manner. Extensions of the disposition agreement filing deadline, which is 150 days after the date the utility files its request, and certain other deadlines are allowed (and under some circumstances are required) and if executed will result in changes to the timeline. Agreements for such extensions, which are limited to a maximum of 60 days, will be reduced to writing and filed in the case file, along with an updated timeline.

The entries in the Target Day column represent the number of days from the date the utility filed its request. The entries in the Target Due Date column show the date when the Target Day hits the calendar. To determine the entries for the Calendar Due Date column, Target Due Dates falling on a weekend or a holiday are moved to the next regular working day, except that the effective dates for pending revised tariff sheets cannot be adjusted.

Request for Increase in Annual Sewer System Operating Revenues MO PSC Sewer Utility Small Company Rate Increase Procedure

Dear Secretary:

WPC Sewer Company holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Missouri Public Service Commission, under which the Company provides treatment services in Pettis County, Missouri. The Commission first authorized the Company to provide regulated sewer utility service in July 26, 1988. The company currently provides service to approximately 67 sewer customers within its certificated service area under the provisions of its Commission-approved tariffs. The Company's customer rates for sewer service were last changed in April 27, 2007.

Pursuant to 4 CSR 240-3.330, the Commission's rule pertaining to rate increase requests made by small sewer utilities, the Company is herby requesting an increase of \$19,207.56 in its annual sewer operating revenues. Based upon current customer rates and customer numbers, this increase represents a change of approximately 100% in the Company's annual sewer system operating revenues. The Company understands that the design of its customer rates, its service charges, its customer service practices, its general business practices and its general tariff provisions will also be reviewed during the Commission Staff's review of the rate increase request, and may thus be the subject of Staff recommendations at the conclusion of the rate increase process.

The specific reasons for the requested increase in the Company's annual operating revenues include: increase in utility plant investment; increase in operation and maintenance expenses; increase in the Commission's annual utility assessments; increase in the Department of Natural Resources' annual sewer discharge permit fees.

Lastly, I wish to advise you that the Company is current on the payment of its Commission annual assessments all past assessments have been paid in full and the current assessment is being paid quarterly and the filing of its Commission annual reports. Additionally, the Company will remain current on these items during this small company rate increase procedure.
