## **NOTICE OF FILING**

COMES NOW Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCPL"), and submits this notice to inform the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the documents that, in accord with the agreements reached during the July 27, 2001 prehearing conference, will retain the "Highly Confidential" designation. In support thereof, KCPL states the following:

- 1. As stated in its Response to Order Directing Filing dated May 1, 2001 ("Response"), and discussed during the prehearing conference held on July 27, 2001, much of KCPL's need for confidentiality in this case no longer exists.
- 2. The Commission's Staff, the Office of the Public Counsel and KCPL have agreed that the only documents that should retain their "Highly Confidential" designation are the documents titled "KCPL 2001 Burner Management System Testing Schedule" and "KCPL 2002 Burner Management System Testing Schedule," which are attached to the Stipulation and Agreement dated March 28, 2001, as Attachment 1 and Attachment 2, respectively, and are also attached to the Response of Kansas City Power & Light Company dated February 26, 2001, as Exhibit A and Exhibit B, respectively ("Testing Schedules").

3. The Parties also agreed that all other documents that were classified as highly confidential may be reclassified as non-proprietary and made public.

WHEREFORE, KCPL respectfully requests that the Commission maintain the "Highly Confidential" designation with respect to the Testing Schedules that are attached to the Stipulation and Agreement dated March 28, 2001, as Attachment 1 and Attachment 2, and to the Response of Kansas City Power & Light Company dated February 26, 2001 as Exhibit A and Exhibit B.
