## ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO FILE COMMENTS

The Commission opened this working case at the request of the Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program to assist in collecting comments and suggestions from interested stakeholders before beginning the formal rulemaking process to amend the Commission's existing manufactured housing rules. As part of this case, the Director held a rulemaking workshop on January 29, 2016 to facilitate discussion about the proposed rule amendments.

On February 3, the Commission's Staff filed a pleading entitled Request for Comment, which explains that the workshop revealed a high level of stakeholder interest in the rule amendments. Staff's pleading includes an attached document that incorporates into the draft rule the notes Staff made about comments received at the January 29 workshop. Staff asks the Commission to establish a time for stakeholders to file written comments about the rule revisions and notes attached to its pleading. Staff also asks that the Director be allowed more time to present the proposed rule amendments to the Commission.

The Commission will grant Staff's request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any stakeholder wishing to file written comments regarding the draft rule amendments and notes attached to Staff's Request for Comment shall do so no later than March 16, 2016.
2. The Director of the Manufactured Housing and Modular Units Program shall present his findings regarding the proposed rule amendments at the Commission's scheduled agenda meeting during the week of April 11, 2016.
3. This order shall be effective when issued.
