APPLICATION OF WESTERN RESOURCES, INC. TO INTERVENE

COMES NOW Western Resources, Inc. (Western Resources), pursuant to 4 C.S.R. 240-2.075 of the Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its Application to Intervene herein states as follows:

1. On May 15, 2000, Kansas City Power & Light Company (KCPL) filed an application in this docket by which it requested authority to restructure and reorganize itself, merge, transfer assets, and form subsidiary corporations as more fully set forth in the application. Among other things, KCPL proposed to create a new corporation (KCPL Power) which would hold and own KCPL's generation assets. As conceived by KCPL and described in its application, KCPL Power

will supply KCPL Delivery [a proposed new transmission and distribution company] with power and energy pursuant to a Power Supply Agreement. Pursuant to that agreement KCPL Power will supply electric energy at wholesale under terms and conditions that will ensure reliable and reasonably priced electric power will be available for distribution by KCPL Delivery to its electric utility customers. It is anticipated that, to the extent practicable given available generation and transmission capacity, KCPL Delivery also will request competitive bids from all interested suppliers of electric energy to supply new and existing load requirements.

Western Resources is a Kansas corporation in good standing in all respects, with its

Western Resources, through its KPL division and its wholly owned subsidiary, Kansas Gas and

Electric Company (KGE), is engaged in the generation, transmission, distribution, and sale of electric

energy and power in the state of Kansas. Western Resources and KGE provide electric service to

over 550,000 residential customers and approximately 80,000 commercial and industrial customers

in Kansas. Western Resources and KGE are directly electrically interconnected with KCPL. KGE

also has joint ownership with KCPL in the Wolf Creek Nuclear Generating Station (Wolf Creek) and

the La Cynge Energy Center (La Cynge). Additionally, Western Resources sells electric power and

energy to and buys electric power and energy from KCPL. Western Resources also buys and sells

power to third parties in direct competition with KCPL.

First, the application may have effects on the ownership and operation of plant jointly owned by KCPL and KGE. Second, Western Resources has a clear interest as a potential supplier of competitively priced electrical power and energy to third parties in competition

As a joint owner, through KGE, in generation with KCPL through its ownership in

with KCPL Power and to KCPL Delivery for new and existing loads since the competitive position

of KCPL may be affected by any ruling in this matter. As this point, however, Western Resources

is unsure of the position it will take in this proceeding.
