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13. The relevant facts in this case are either well known or undisputed.

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
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\*\*\* There is no need to embark in an investigation to determine the facts or the law. Because the facts are either well known or undisputed and the basis for the Commission's jurisdiction can be

found in the laws of this State, there is no reason to open a case to examine the subject matter of the Transaction. There is simply nothing to investigate.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons aforesaid, and given the anticipated timeframe from closing of the Transaction, Aquila respectfully requests that the Commission deny Staff's Motion to Open Case for lack of subject-matter jurisdiction over the contemplated Transaction at its earliest opportunity and for such other orders and relief as may be appropriate in the circumstances.
