ADDENDUM TO NON-UNANIMOUS STIPULATION AND AGREEMENT

COME NOW The Empire District Electric Company ("EDE"), Midwest Energy Consumers Group ("MECG"); Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff"); Renew Missouri Advocates ("Renew Missouri"); and, Missouri Department of Economic Development – Division of Energy ("DE") (collectively, the "Signatories"), by and through their respective counsel, and, for their Addendum to Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement (this "Stipulation"), respectfully state as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. On April 24, 2018, the Signatories filed a Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement with the Commission that was subsequently objected to by the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) and the City of Joplin.
- 2. As was discussed in the OPC Motion to Suspend Procedural Schedule filed on May 2, 2018, and further discussed in the Signatories' Response in Opposition to OPC's Motions to Suspend Procedural Schedule filed May 4, 2018, the Signatories have determined that the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement should be amended to clarify their intent related to two provisions.
 - 3. Accordingly, the Signatories agree to amend the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and

Agreement as follows:

14. Acquisition of Wind Projects. The Signatories recommend that any order of the Commission approving this Stipulation contain the following language:

a. The Signatories agree EDE, through its ownership in Wind Holdco(s), will is authorized to enter into purchase agreement(s) for a nameplate capacity of up to 600 MW of Wind Projects that meet the following criteria: (i) are located within the Southwest Power Pool footprint with energy and capacity deliverable to the EDE service territory;

18. Tax Equity.

a. <u>The Signatories agree</u> EDE, through its ownership in Wind Holdco(s), <u>will</u> is authorized to contract with tax equity partner(s) for financing of the Wind Projects (a tax equity agreement) so long as consistent with

WHEREFORE, the Signatories respectfully request the Commission consider this addendum to the Non-Unanimous Stipulation and Agreement.
