Comes now Great Plains Energy Incorporated ("GPE"), and submits under seal as "Proprietary" its Quarterly Report on Form U-9C-3 for the Quarter ended September 30, 2002. In support thereof, GPE states:

- 1. GPE has indirect investments in "energy-related companies", as defined in Rule 58 of the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935 (the "Act"). GPE is required under Rule 58 to file with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC"), and with each state commission having jurisdiction over the retail rates of the public utility subsidiary of GPE, a Quarterly Report on Form U-9C-3. The referenced case was established to receive such reports.
- 2. GPE has filed with the SEC on a confidential basis, pursuant to Rule 104 of the Act, its entire Quarterly Report on Form U-9C-3. This follows the practice of certain registered holding company systems, including Ameren Corporation, of filing the entire report confidentially with the SEC.
- 3. In conformance with the confidential filing of this report with the SEC, and with the Commission's protective order in this case, GPE respectfully submits under seal eight copies of its Quarterly Report on Form U-9C-3 for the period ended September 30, 2002 and requests that it be afforded confidential treatment as "Proprietary Information".
