NOTICE CANCELLING PREHEARING CONFERENCE
AND FILING OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On January 27, 1999, Central Missouri Telecommunications, Inc. (CMT), a Delaware corporation authorized to transact business in Missouri, filed its application with the Commission seeking authority to provide basic local exchange telecommunications services and local exchange telecommunications services throughout the exchanges served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT) and Sprint Missouri, Inc., doing business as Sprint (Sprint). On February 3, 1999, SWBT filed an application to intervene, which the Commission granted on February 9, 1999. Thereafter, on March 16, 1999, the Commission by order set a prehearing conference for April 1, 1999, and required the parties to jointly file a proposed procedural schedule by April 8, 1999.

On March 26, 1999, the parties filed their Stipulation and Agreement disposing of all issues. Therefore, the prehearing conference set for April 1, 1999, is cancelled and the parties are relieved of the requirement to file a proposed procedural schedule.
