NOTICE OF VOLUNTARY DISMISSAL

COMES NOW TUK LLC. (“TUK” or the “Company”), by and through its undersigned counsel, and, in accordance with Missouri Public Service Commission (“Commission”) Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1), voluntarily dismisses its Request for Rate Increase in this matter:

1. On January 31, 2017, TUK submitted a Request for Rate Increase under Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050.
2. The filing was made to comply with the Commission’s Order Approving Stipulation and Agreement and Granting Certificate of Convenience and Necessity in Case No. WA-2015-0169, wherein the Commission ordered TUK to file a small utility rate case pursuant to Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-3.050, no later than eighteen (18) months after the effective date of the tariff sheets required by the Order. Those tariff sheets became effective on January 1, 2016. The increase requested was \$1.
3. Since TUK’s filing, it has provided Staff and OPC with information requested by those entities for the purpose of reviewing TUK’s rates.
4. TUK does not seek to pursue a rate increase and its filing of this matter and the opportunity for the Staff and OPC to review TUK’s rates has satisfied the cited requirement in the Commission’s Order in Case No. WA-2015-0169.
5. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(1) states that “An applicant . . . may voluntarily dismiss an application . . . without an order of the commission at any time before prepared testimony has been filed or oral evidence has been offered, by filing a

notice of dismissal with the commission and serving a copy on all parties.” Prepared testimony has not been filed in this case.

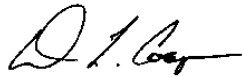
6. Further, 4 CSR 240-3.050(23) states, in part, that “If at any time after a case is opened . . . the utility advises the staff that it no longer wishes to pursue an increase, the staff shall file a verified statement to that effect in the case file, whereupon the regulatory law judge shall issue a notice closing the case.” Because TUK is able to file its own statement, it would appear that the verified Staff statement is not necessary.

7. For the reasons stated above, TUK hereby dismisses its Request for Rate Increase.

8. Counsel for TUK has provided this motion to counsel for Staff and OPC and they have stated that they have no objection to such dismissal.

WHEREFORE, TUK respectfully requests that the Commission recognize this Notice of Dismissal and issue a notice closing the case.
