NOTICE REQUIRING FILING

New Edge Network, Inc. d/b/a New Edge Networks (New Edge) applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on October 29, 1999, for a certificate of service authority to provide

all forms of resold and facilities based intrastate interexchange telecommunications service and non-switched local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri pursuant to Sections 392.361 and 392.420 of the Missouri Revised Statutes.

The proper statutes for an applicant to cite are Sections 392.410 through 492.455.¹

New Edge also indicates that it will provide services under the name of New Edge Networks. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(4)(D) states that applications for a certificate of service authority shall include, if the applicant does business under a fictitious name, "...a copy of the registration of the fictitious name with the secretary of state...." No such document was included with New Edge's application.

¹ Sections 392.410, 392.420, 392.450, and 392.451 are found in the 1998 Supplement. All other statutory references are to the Revised Statutes of Missouri 1994 unless otherwise indicated. Section 392.361 refers to competitive classification which is correctly pleaded in paragraph III.1. of the application.

The Commission cannot proceed with this case until New Edge files pleadings in conformance with the Commission's rules.
