NOTICE OF DEFICIENCY

On February 24, 2000, Spectra Communications Group, LLC (Spectra) and Mark Twain Communications Company (Mark Twain) filed their joint application requesting the Commission's approval of an interconnection and unbundling agreement under the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The joint application identified the parties by name and indicated prior case numbers under which filings had been submitted to the Commission by these parties.

Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) requires that, in addition to the legal name of the applicants, the application shall include the street and mailing address of the principal office or place of business of the applicants. The joint application of Spectra and Mark Twain fails to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) because it does not include the street and mailing address of the principal office or place of business of the applicants. Therefore, the joint application of Spectra and Mark Twain requesting approval of the interconnection and unbundling agreement is deficient. The joint

applicants are directed to comply with Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.060(1)(A) no later than 4:00 p.m. on March 17, 2000.
