SUPPLEMENT TO APPLICATION

Pathnet, Inc. (Applicant or Pathnet), a Delaware corporation, files this supplement to its application in order to conform the application to the Commission's revision of its rules at 4 CSR 240.

Pathnet's original application, filed on April 19, 2000, contained among other things a request that its services be categorized as competitive and a request for waiver of several of the Commission's rules that have previously been waived for carriers offering only competitive services. We were subsequently informed by PSC staff member Walter Cecil that Pathnet's application would be evaluated pursuant to the new rules, and as a result, some changes needed to be made in our requests for waivers. After reviewing the new provisions with Mr. Cecil, Pathnet offers the following as a replacement for paragraph 6 of its original application:

6. Applicant also requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo (Cumm. Supp. 1994), that the Commission waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of the applicant:
