STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

- 1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") grant essential.com, Inc. (Applicant) a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services and a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services, restricted to dedicated, private line services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See sections 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo 1994).
- 2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See section 392.361.2 RSMo 1994). All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See section 392.361.3 RSMo 1994).

3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Commission's April 18, 2000, Notice of Applications. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain statutes if the Commission determines that the waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See sections 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994 and section 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999).

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends that the Commission grant essential.com, Inc. a certificate to provide interexchange telecommunications services; a certificate to provide basic local telecommunications services, restricted to dedicated, private line services; grant Applicant competitive classification; approve Applicant's proposed tariff, MO P.S.C. No. 1, sheets 1-30, with an effective date of May 22, 2000; and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications.
