

**MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Comes now **ONSITE ACCESS LOCAL, LLC** (hereinafter "OnSite" or "Applicant") and for its above-entitled motion states the following to the Commission:

1. On June 28, 2000, the Commission approved a procedural schedule in the referenced matter. Pursuant to that procedural schedule order, testimony by the Applicant is due to be filed on October 16, 2000.

2. As was stated in the parties' proposed procedural schedule, it is anticipated that this matter can be resolved by stipulation. OnSite has prepared the draft of the stipulation and will submit it to the parties this week for approval. Onsite believes that the matter will resolved without necessity of hearing.


3. As a result, OnSite respectfully requests the Commission suspend the procedural schedule for a period of 90 days, and unless a stipulation is filed within that time, then direct that another procedural schedule be filed in the case.

4. Counsel for the Staff of the Commission, counsel for intervener, Southwestern Bell Telephone Company and Public Counsel have no objection to this request for a suspension of the procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, OnSite respectfully requests the Commission to suspend the procedural schedule ordered on June 28, 2000; further ordering that, if a stipulation is not filed for Commission review within 90 days of the Commission's order, then at a time appointed by the Commission, the parties will file a procedural schedule for disposition of the case.
