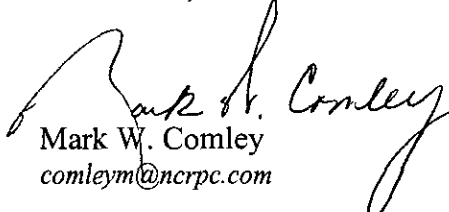

MOTION TO SUSPEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

1. On June 28, 2000, the Commission approved a procedural schedule in the referenced matter. Pursuant to that procedural schedule order, testimony by the Applicant is due to be filed on October 2, 2000.

2. As was stated in the parties' proposed procedural schedule, it is anticipated that this matter can be resolved by stipulation. 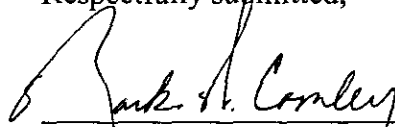
4. Counsel for the Staff of the Commission and counsel for Southwestern Bell have no objection to this request for a suspension of the procedural schedule.

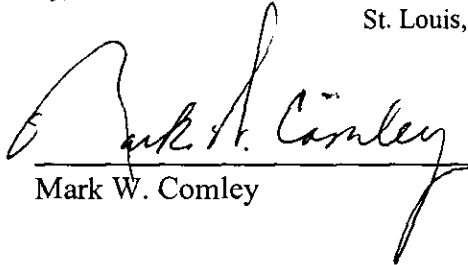
