

**ORDER APPROVING INTEREXCHANGE AND NONSWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE**  
**CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND ORDER APPROVING TARIFF**

JirehCom, Inc. (JirehCom) applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on June 26, 2000, for certificates of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in Missouri under Sections 392.410-.450, RSMo 1994, and RSMo Supp. 1999.<sup>1</sup> JirehCom asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and to waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420. JirehCom is an Illinois corporation with its principal office located at 2383 Centennial Drive, Washington, Illinois 61571.

The Commission issued a Notice of Applications for Intrastate Certificates of Service Authority and Opportunity to Intervene on July 11, 2000, directing parties wishing to intervene to file their requests by July 26, 2000. The requirement for a hearing is met when the opportunity for hearing has been provided and no proper party has requested the opportunity to present evidence. State ex rel.

Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission,  
776 S.W.2d 494, 496 (Mo. App. 1989). Since no one has asked permission to intervene or requested a hearing, the Commission may grant the relief requested based on the application.

JirehCom filed a proposed tariff in conjunction with its application and filed substitute sheets on July 22 and August 4, 2000. The tariff's effective date is August 24, 2000. JirehCom's tariff describes the rates, rules, and regulations it intends to use, identifies JirehCom as a competitive company, and lists the waivers requested. JirehCom intends to provide interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services including 1+, 800/888/877 Services, Directory Assistance, and Travel Card Services.

In its memorandum filed on August 9, 2000, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) stated that JirehCom's proposed services are similar to existing IXC offerings. Staff recommended that the Commission grant JirehCom a certificate of interexchange service authority, and a certificate of service authority for local exchange telecommunications services on condition that this authority be restricted to providing dedicated private line services. Staff recommended that the Commission grant JirehCom competitive status, and waiver of the statutes and rules listed in the Notice. Staff recommended that the Commission approve the proposed tariff as amended to become effective on August 24, 2000.

The Commission finds that competition in the intrastate interexchange and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications markets is in the public interest and JirehCom should be granted

certificates of service authority. The Commission finds that the services JirehCom proposes to offer are competitive and JirehCom should be classified as a competitive company. The Commission finds that waiving the statutes and Commission rules set out in the ordered paragraph below is reasonable and not detrimental to the public interest.

The Commission finds that JirehCom's proposed tariff details the services, equipment, and pricing it proposes to offer, and is similar to tariffs approved for other Missouri certificated inter-exchange and nonswitched local exchange carriers. The Commission finds that the proposed tariff filed on June 26, 2000, shall be approved as amended to become effective on August 24, 2000.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:**

1. That JirehCom, Inc., is granted a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri, subject to the conditions of certification set out above.

2. That JirehCom, Inc., is granted a certificate of service authority to provide nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services in the state of Missouri limited to providing dedicated private line services, subject to all applicable statutes and Commission rules except as specified in this order.

3. That JirehCom, Inc., is classified as a competitive telecommunications company. Application of the following statutes and regulatory rules shall be waived:

- 4 CSR 240-30.010(2)(C) - posting of tariffs
- 4 CSR 240-30.040 - uniform system of accounts
- 4 CSR 240-33.030 - minimum charges
- 4 CSR 240-35 - reporting of bypass and  
customer-specific arrangements

4. That the tariff filed by JirehCom, Inc., on June 26, 2000, under tariff number 200001203, is approved as amended to become effective on August 24, 2000. The tariff approved is:
