## **ORDER DIRECTING FILING**

Pathnet, Inc. (Pathnet), applied to the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) on April 19, 2000, for a certificate of service authority under Section 392.410 - .450, RSMo 1994, and RSMo Supp. 1999, to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services, and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services restricted to dedicated private line services. Pathnet asked the Commission to classify it as a competitive company and waive certain statutes and rules as authorized by Sections 392.361 and 392.420.

The Commission approved Pathnet's Certificate of Service Authority in an order issued June 19, 2000. There, Pathnet was directed to file its tariff within 45 days of the effective date of that order, that is, by August 14, 2000.

On August 14, 2000, Pathnet filed a letter requesting to extend the date for filing the initial tariff for Pathnet from August 14, 2000, to August 21, 2000. The letter states that the General Counsel's Office does not object to the extension.

Pathnet has failed to read the Commission's June 19, 2000, order. The August 14, 2000, filing date was ordered by the Commission based on

Staff's Recommendation. Pathnet is now out of time in its initial tariff filing.

The Commission will direct Pathnet to file a Motion for an Extension of Time to File its initial tariff, detailing the reason for its delay in filing its tariff. In the alternative, Pathnet shall file its initial tariff along with a Motion for Leave to File Out of Time.

The Commission's practice rules do not contemplate a Motion for an Extension of Time to File being presented informally, in letter form.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- 1. That Pathnet, Inc., shall file a Motion for an Extension of Time to File its initial tariff, detailing the reason for its delay in filing its tariff, or, in the alternative, Pathnet, Inc., shall file its initial tariff along with a Motion for Leave to File Out of Time.
  - 2. That this order shall become effective on August 16, 2000.
