## MOTION TO AMEND APPLICATION BY INTERLINEATION

Comes now essential.com, Inc. ("Applicant" or "essential"), by and through counsel, and for its Motion To Amend Application By Interlineation respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On April 6, 2000 Applicant filed its Application in this proceeding.
- 2. Shortly thereafter, Applicant was informed by Staff that the standard Commission waivers requested by Applicant in is Application contained certain errors although the remainder of Applicant's Application was in the standard Commission form and was acceptable to Staff.
- 3. Applicant intended only to ask for those statutory and rule waivers routinely granted by the Commission for interexchange and nonswitched local exchange carriers.
- 4. Applicant's counsel discussed how best to resolve this issue with Staff and it was agreed that since the only problem involved the listing of the "standard" waivers, Applicant should amend its Application via this Motion rather than by re-filing a completely new Application. Applicant also is this date filing substitute tariff sheets which accurately reflect the "standard" waivers.
- 5. As such, Applicant hereby amends its Application as follows: on page 3, paragraph 5, delete all the statutes and rules listed therein and insert in lieu thereof the following:
