STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

- In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff 1. recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel KCI Long Distance, Inc.'s certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.
- 2. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410, RSMo which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel KCI Long Distance, Inc.'s certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff.



On June 20, 2000, KCI Long Distance, Inc. (KCI), a competitive telecommunications company, filed an Application to Cancel Certfiate of Service Authority. KCI was certificated by this Commission to provide interexchange telecommunications services on November 19, 1997 in Case No. TA-98-105. KCI does not currently serve any interexchange customers in Missouri and has no plans to serve customers in the future.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has no objections to KCI's application and recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel KCI's certificate of service authority and accompanying tariff at its earliest convenience. The Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or which would be affected by this proposal.

According to the application, KCI has no assessment fees due. Staff contacted the Internal Accounting Department and received confirmation that KCI does not owe any assessment.
