STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation respectfully states:

1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel MiComm Services, Inc.'s conditional certificate of service authority.

2. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410, RSMo which provides:

Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected.

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo. App. 1989).

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends the Commission issue an order canceling MiComm Services, Inc.'s conditional certificate of service authority.

DATE: June 29, 2000

On June 29, 2000, MiComm Services, Inc. (MSI), a competitive telecommunications company, filed an Application for Cancellation of Certificate. MSI was granted a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services in Case No. TA-98-93. The Commission's December 23, 1997, Order Granting Certificate states that MSI's certificate will become effective when MSI's tariff becomes effective. MSI never filed proposed tariffs so its certificate is not effective.

The Telecommunications Department Staff (Staff) has no objections to MSI's application and recommends that the Commission issue an order to cancel MSI's pending certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications services at its earliest convenience. The Staff is unaware of any other filing which affects or which would be affected by this proposal.
