

**NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS AND RIGHT TO INTERVENE  
AND ORDER TO FILE TARIFF**

§§ 392.361.2, 392.440, and 392.450 RSMo 1994 require the Missouri Public Service Commission to give all telecommunications companies notice and an opportunity to be heard regarding whether a telecommunications company should be granted a certificate of service authority or be classified as a competitive company. YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that each applicant listed in the schedule accompanying this notice has applied to the Commission for a certificate of service authority to provide intrastate interexchange telecommunications services and/or non-switched local exchange telecommunications services under §§ 392.410 through 392.450 RSMo 1994. Each applicant has also requested classification as a competitive company that may be subjected to a lesser degree of regulation. If competitive status is granted, the Commission will grant waiver of the following statutes and Commission rules as authorized by §§ 392.361.5 and 392.420 RSMo 1994:


The Commission must approve a certificate of service authority for the resale of interexchange telecommunication services or local exchange services upon a showing by the Applicant, and a finding by the Commission, that the grant of authority is in the public interest. § 392.440 RSMo 1994. The Commission may classify a company as competitive only if it finds that all telecommunications services offered by that company are competitive services. § 392.361.3 RSMo 1994. Certificates of service authority and competitive classification will be granted to the listed applicants, upon favorable recommendation by Commission staff, without hearing unless a proper party intervenes and requests a hearing. A proper party is one who desires to contest whether it is in the public interest to grant an Applicant a certificate of service authority or competitive status.

If you wish to intervene you must file a written application to intervene on or before 3:00 p.m. on the date specified for intervention on the Schedule of Applicants (attached). You should address your Application to Intervene to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102, and serve copies on the applicant, the applicant's attorney, and all known intervenors. Any party may object, in writing, to an Application to Intervene giving the reasons for the objection. Objections must be filed with the Commission no later than ten days after the Application to Intervene was filed.

Any person desiring a copy of the application filed by any of the companies listed below may receive one upon written request to the Executive Secretary of the Missouri Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 360, Jefferson City, Missouri 65102.

Each applicant listed on the accompanying Schedule of Applicants shall file with the Commission a proposed tariff no later than ten days after the intervention date. The tariff must carry an effective date that is at least 30 days later than the intervention date. The proposed tariff should reflect the rates, rules, and regulations the company intends to use for providing services in Missouri.
