STAFF RECOMMENDATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and for its recommendation states:

1. In the attached Memorandum, which is labeled Appendix A, the Staff recommends that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) grant TDS Long Distance Corporation (Applicant) a certificate of authority to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services. The Commission shall grant an application for a certificate of telecommunications service authority upon a finding that the grant of authority is in the public interest. (See §§ 392.430 and 392.440 RSMo 1994.)

2. Staff also recommends that the Commission classify the Applicant and its services as competitive. The Commission may classify a telecommunications provider or its services as competitive if the Commission determines it is subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. (See § 392.361.2 RSMo 1994.) All the services a competitive company provides must be classified as competitive. (See § 392.361.3 RSMo 1994.)

3. Staff further recommends that the Commission approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Application. The Commission may waive the application of its rules and certain

statutes if the Commission determines that waiver is consistent with the purposes of Chapter 392 RSMo. (See §§ 392.361.3 and 392.420 RSMo 1994, and § 392.185 RSMo Supp. 1999.)

4. Finally, Staff recommends that the Commission grant approval of the applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO No. 1.

WHEREFORE, Staff recommends that the Commission grant TDS Long Distance Corporation a certificate to provide interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services, grant Applicant competitive classification, approve Applicant's proposed tariff, PSC MO No. 1 with a proposed effective date of August 1, 2000, and approve the waivers listed in the Notice of Applications.
