### NOTIFICATION

COMES NOW Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri" or "Company") and, pursuant to the terms of its tariffs approved to implement the energy efficiency portfolio approved in this case, submits the following:

- 1. Ameren Missouri's Change Process tariff, found at Sheet No. 221.4 of its Energy Efficiency MEEIA 2019-21 tariffs, states that the Company will file a notice in this case prior to making a change in its measure and/or incentive amount offering.
- 2. Ameren Missouri is modifying several of its programs in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. Many aspects of its Single Family Income Eligible ("SFIE"), its Multifamily Income Eligible program ("MFIE"), and its Multifamily Market Rate ("MFMR") programs have been difficult to accomplish given measures taken for public safety such as social distancing. Ameren Missouri is targeting unoccupied residences through the remainder of 2020 as a safer alternative to accomplish the intent of the program. The Company will also continue to pursue exterior savings opportunities such as Air Conditioner ("AC") tune-ups and exterior lighting. The Company is not making any changes to incentives offered as a result of these revisions. Generally, the revisions are as follows:
  - **SFIE programs**: The delivery strategy will target the highest need neighborhoods by focusing on:

- Income eligible unoccupied qualified homes (e.g., transitioning to a new tenant); and
- Exterior contactless AC tune-up, including self-install energy efficiency packages.
- **MFIE programs**: The programs will be refocused to:
  - o Unoccupied area and exterior lighting phases of multifamily projects;
  - Virtual inspections, assessments, and Quality Assurance/Quality Control ("QA/QC"); and
  - Unoccupied multifamily properties and properties unoccupied due to being repurposed to multifamily properties.
- **MFMR programs:** The programs will be refocused to:
  - o Unoccupied area and exterior lighting phases of multifamily projects;
  - Virtual inspections, assessments, and QA/QC; and
  - Unoccupied multifamily properties and properties unoccupied due to being repurposed to multifamily properties.
- 3. Attachment A to this *Notification* contains a webpage mockup of the proposed changes. Ameren Missouri will launch these program modifications on June 15, 2020.

**WHEREFORE**, Ameren Missouri respectfully files this *Notification* in compliance with the terms of its tariff.
