Southwestern Bell Telephone Company respectfully requests the Commission to accept for filing its out of time Response to Chariton Valley Telephone Corporation's Motion to Dismiss in this case. In support of its Motion, Southwestern Bell states:

- 1. Southwestern Bell believes Chariton Valley filed its Motion to Dismiss Complaint in this case on January 10, 2000.
- 2. Under Commission Procedural Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(12), parties are allowed ten days from the date of filing in which to respond to any motion unless otherwise ordered by the Commission. Under this Rule, Southwestern Bell's Response to Chariton Valley's Motion to Dismiss was due January 20, 2000.
- 3. Southwestern Bell's counsel misdocketed this response date on his calendar and just discovered his error.
- 4. Southwestern Bell has served a copy of this Motion and the accompanying Response on Chariton Valley's counsel by hand today. Given that this case is just commencing and that there would have been at least a three day delay from service by mail even if the Response had been timely filed, the filing of the Response six days past its due date should not prejudice any party.
