SECOND ORDER DIRECTING FILING

The Commission issued an Order Amending Certificate to Provide Basic Local Telecommunications Services on October 26, 2000. Ordered Paragraph 3 directed the applicant, Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Snappy Phone (Snappy Phone), to file an appropriate proposed tariff no later than December 4, 2000.

Snappy Phone did not file a proposed tariff as directed. Therefore, the Commission issued an Order Directing Filing on January 4, 2001, directing the applicant to file a status report no later than February 5, 2001, informing the Commission of when the company intends to file its proposed tariff. On February 6, 2001, Snappy Phone filed a letter indicating that the prospective tariff filing date is March 1, 2001.

Snappy Phone filed a proposed tariff on February 22, 2001. By letter filed March 2, 2001, Snappy Phone withdrew the proposed tariff.

There have been no filings in this case since the March 2, 2001, letter from Snappy Phone. The Commission will direct Snappy Phone to file a proposed tariff, or an appropriate pleading updating the Commission on the status of its proposed tariff filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That no later than June 26, 2001, Snappy Phone of Texas, Inc., d/b/a Snappy Phone, shall file either a proposed tariff or an appropriate pleading updating the Commission as to the status of its proposed tariff filing.

2. That this order shall become effective on June 22, 2001.
