

2	Α.	Yes. Based on the testimony of other intervenors, I have the following additional
3		recommendation:
4		1) The Commission should reject Ameren's proposed wholesale solution with
5		Noranda, as will be detailed by Walmart's counsel in briefs at the appropriate
6		time.

11 [·]	Q.	WHAT IS YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF AMEREN'S PROPOSAL TO ADDRESS
12 [`]	•	NORANDA'S INITIAL PROPOSAL IN THIS CASE?
13	. A.	My understanding is that Ameren has proposed that the Commission release Noranda
14		from its certificate of convenience and necessity, under which Noranda takes retail
15		service from Ameren, and for Noranda to enter in to a five-year wholesale power
16		contract with Ameren. See Amended Rebuttal Testimony of Matt Michels, page 31,
17		line 12 to line 16.
18	Q.	HOW WOULD OTHER CUSTOMERS BE IMPACTED BY AMEREN'S PROPOSAL?
19	Α.	Other customers would bear the reduction in cost to Noranda for the proposed five-
20		year term. Id., page 35, line 4 to line 5. Ameren proposes to treat revenues from their
21		proposal as off-system sales revenues and would flow through those revenues to
22		other customers through the Fuel Adjustment Clause. Id., line 12 to line 14.
