NOTICE REGARDING INCONSISTENT PLEADINGS

On December 5, 1997, Tin Can Communications Company (Tin Can) filed an application for a certificate of service authority to provide basic local telecommunications service. All parties except the Office of the Public Counsel (OPC) filed a Stipulation and Agreement on February 17, 1998, requesting authority for Tin Can to provide both basic local service and dedicated, non-switched local exchange services. OPC did not oppose the Stipulation and Agreement or request a hearing. The suggestions filed by the Commission's Staff (Staff) on March 2 discussed only Tin Can's proposed basic local telecommunications service.

No action will be taken to approve or reject the Stipulation and Agreement until the signatories clarify whether Tin Can seeks to provide only basic local telecommunications service, or dedicated, non-switched local exchange services as well.
