## MOTION TO OPEN CASE AND CANCEL CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves that the Commission open a case and cancel the certificate of service authority it has granted to Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment. In support of its Motion, Staff respectfully states as follows:

- 1. On December 5, 1997, the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issued an order granting a certificate of service authority to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment to Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems in Case No. TA-98-137.
- 2. Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems has now requested that Commission cancel its certificate of service authority because is no longer providing service in Missouri and wishes to exit the state. See Appendix A.
- 3. The web site of the Office of the Missouri Secretary of State reports that the authority of Com-Tech Resources, Inc., a Texas corporation, to do business in Missouri was revoked on August 29, 2006 because the company failed to file its Annual Registration Report. Section 351.602.3 RSMo. (2000) states that "[t]he authority of a foreign corporation to transact business in this state ceases on the date shown on the certificate revoking its certificate of authority."

- 4. No complaints have been filed against the company since the commencement of the Electronic Filing and Information System.
- 5. Because Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems has requested cancellation of its certificate, because it is no longer authorized to do business in Missouri, and because it is not providing telecommunications service, the Staff recommends that the Commission issue an order canceling Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems's certificate of service authority, as well as its tariff.
- 6. The Commission has the authority to cancel a telecommunications corporation certificate pursuant to Section 392.410.5 RSMo (Supp. 2006), which provides:

"Any certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

However, the Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing. *State ex rel. Rex Deffenderfer Enterprises, Inc. v. Public Service Commission*, 776 S.W.2d 494 (Mo.App. 1989).

7. This pleading is being served on the address provided most recently by the company to the Commission via certified mail, as well as upon its Missouri registered agent. Staff has verified that the address listed on the letter received is incorrect and the address currently reflected in EFIS is still the correct address.

WHEREFORE, the Staff recommends the Commission cancel the certificate of service authority of Com-Tech Resources, Inc. d/b/a Com-Tech Systems to provide private pay telephone service in the State of Missouri via customer-owned coin-operated telephone equipment.
