**C. The Service to be offered by Applicant and the Territory to be served**

Applicant is a reseller of long-distance telephone services offered by facilities-based inter-exchange carriers. Applicant neither owns, leases, nor operates any switching, transmission, or other physical facilities in the State of Missouri, and no such facilities will be used by Applicant in providing long-distance service in the State of Missouri. Upon receiving certification, Applicant intends to provide telecommunications services, including outbound 1+ dialing, inbound 800/888 toll-free, travel card and prepaid calling card services, throughout the State of Missouri.

Applicant intends to provide these services throughout the United States and is currently in the process of obtaining all required authorizations from the various public services and utilities commissions. Applicant intends to provide high quality services, with an industry standard blocking rate less than P.01. Its services will be available on a full-time basis, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, to customers within the geographic boundaries of the State of Missouri.

There are no unsatisfied judgements against this company.

There are no annual reports or assessments fees that are overdue.

**E. Managerial and Technical Qualifications**

Applicant's key management personnel have extensive experience. Furthermore, since Applicant will be providing services as a reseller, Applicant will also rely up the technical expertise of its facilities-based underlying carriers which upon initially will be WilTel, MCI WorldCom, & Frontier/Global Crossing.

**F. Competition Will Be Enhanced by Applicant's Offerings**

Grant of this Petition will further the public interest by expanding the availability of competitive telecommunications services in the State. In addition, intrastate offering of these services is in the public interest because the services will provide customers with access to new technologies and service choices, and can permit customers to achieve increased efficiencies and cost savings. Applicant's entry into the intrastate inter-exchange telecommunications services market thereby will enhance the telecommunications infrastructure in the State and will facilitate economic development.

In particular, the public will benefit directly, through the use of the competitive services to be offered by Applicant, and indirectly, because the presence of Applicant in this market will increase the incentives for other telecommunications providers to operate more efficiently, offer more innovative services, reduce their prices, and improve their quality of service.
