In support of its application, IP states as follows:

- 1. Applicant IP Communications Corporation, d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation, is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Texas, and has a certificate of authority to conduct business in the State of Missouri. - 3. IP proposes to provide interexchange telecommunications service, including both inbound and outbound intraLATA services, and dedicated non-switched local exchange telecommunications service on a facilities and resold basis, throughout the state of Missouri.
 - 4. Pursuant to this application, IP seeks to offer and provide all forms of

interexchange and dedicated, non-switched local telecommunications service, including xDSL, point-to-point T1, DS1, DS3, and other data communications services.

- 5. IP possesses the technical and managerial expertise and experience necessary to provide the services it proposes. IP also possesses the necessary financial resources to provide the services it proposes.
- 6. IP seeks classification as a competitive telecommunications company pursuant to Section 392.420 RSMO. IP believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. Granting of this application will allow greater price and service options for telephone users..
- 7. IP is willing to comply with all applicable Commission rules except those that are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to a request filed by IP. Consistent with the Commission's treatment of other certificated competitive interexchange and local exchange telecommunications companies, IP requests that the following statutes and regulations be waived for IP and its interexchange and non-switched local exchange service offerings:

Prompt approval of this application also will expand the availability of innovative, high quality, and reliable telecommunications services within the State of Missouri.

WHEREFORE, applicant IP Communications Corporation, d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange telecommunications service and non-switched local exchange telecommunications service as herein requested, classify IP Communications Corporation, d/b/a IP Communications of the Southwest Corporation as a competitive telecommunications company, and grant a waiver of the aforesaid statutes and regulations.
