

**APPLICATION**

Comes now **TELIGENT SERVICES, INC.** (hereinafter "Applicant" or "TSI"), and hereby applies for and requests a Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange and Local Exchange Intrastate Telecommunications Services between and among locations within the State of Missouri pursuant to Sections 392.430, 392.440, 392.450, and 392.451, RSMo. 1994, an order classifying Applicant's services as competitive telecommunications services, and an order waiving or suspending certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to the federal Telecommunications Act of 1996 and state laws. In support of its request, Applicant states as follows:

1. TSI is a newly created Delaware corporation. A copy of TSI's Certificate of Incorporation, Articles of Incorporation and Authority to Transact Business in the State of Missouri are attached hereto as Exhibit 1. Its principal office and place of business is located at:

2. TSI was created by Teligent, Inc. in connection with a comprehensive corporate restructuring by which TSI will act as Teligent's operating company to provide telecommunications services to customers and will be the direct parent of Teligent's other current domestic subsidiaries.

Teligent will restructure itself similarly to the holding company structure used by numerous other certificated carriers in Missouri. Upon receipt of the necessary regulatory approvals<sup>1</sup>, all of the state authorizations currently held by Teligent will be assigned directly, or in effect, to TSI, and Teligent's employees who are dedicated to telecommunications services will be transferred internally to TSI's operations. Attached as Exhibit 2 are charts showing Teligent's current and proposed corporate structure.

4. Applicant seeks authority to provide local exchange and basic local exchange telecommunications services in all exchanges currently served by Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), GTE and Sprint. A list of the SWBT, GTE, and Sprint exchanges in which

Applicant seeks authority is set forth on Exhibit 3. Pursuant to applicable law, and subject to Applicant's right under federal or state laws to seek to offer, and offer and provide service in geographical areas smaller than an exchange or in market segmentations or to offer customer specific pricing, similarly situated subscribers located within the listed exchanges will receive services on equal terms and conditions as set forth in Applicant's tariffs.

5. On December 4, 1998 SWBT and Teligent executed an interconnection agreement which was approved by this Commission in Case No. TO-99-299 in a report and order dated April 5, 1999. According to the express terms of the interconnection agreement approved between SWB and Teligent, the agreement applies as well to the subsidiaries of Teligent TSI is a subsidiary of Teligent and therefore is covered by the terms of the approved interconnection agreement. SWBT has further agreed to consent in writing to Teligent's assignment of its rights, duties and obligations under the interconnection agreement to TSI. At this time, a copy of the consent is unavailable but will be late filed as Exhibit 4 to this application when it is delivered to TSI or its attorneys.

6. Applicant intends to offer its services in accord with its tariffs, and proposed tariffs bearing a 45 day effective date are attached as Exhibit 5.

7. TSI is technically and managerially qualified to provide the proposed services within the State of Missouri.

8. TSI possesses the same managerial ability to provide the proposed telecommunications service within the state of Missouri that the Commission found Teligent to possess in Case No. TA-98-258. As set forth in Exhibit 6, Teligent's current senior management team, which will be the senior management team of TSI, has extensive competitive telecommunications experience in the provision of competitive telecommunications services, including wireless services. Indeed, the highly qualified team was assembled because of their unique

qualifications to operate, manage, and market Teligent's telecommunications businesses. This experience, coupled with the progress Teligent has made to date in building and operating its local and long distance networks, demonstrates TSI's managerial ability to provide facilities-based service in the State of Missouri.

9. In addition, TSI possesses the requisite technical ability to provide service in the State of Missouri. Teligent has already constructed many of its local communications networks and is currently serving customers in 29 of the nation's top markets, including New York, Los Angeles, Chicago, Houston, Philadelphia, Dallas-Fort Worth, San Diego, San Antonio, San Jose, San Francisco-Oakland, Baltimore, Jacksonville, Milwaukee, Washington D.C., Boston, Austin, Denver, Atlanta, Miami-Fort Lauderdale, Orlando, Tampa, Richmond, West Palm Beach, Wilmington, Del., New Orleans, Sacramento, Cleveland, Seattle, and Phoenix. Teligent's subsidiaries currently have FCC licenses to provide its facilities-based service in approximately 74 markets, in 39 states and the District of Columbia. Teligent is currently authorized to provide the full range of telecommunications services in all 39 of these states and the District of Columbia. Through the technical telecommunications experience of Teligent's current officers, directors, and employees, as well as the technologically advanced state of the art equipment it has developed and is currently developing in conjunction with numerous vendors, TSI has the requisite technical ability to render the telecommunications services for which authority is sought herein.

10. Finally, TSI possesses the requisite financial ability to provide telecommunications services within the State of Missouri. TSI will rely on the financial resources of its parent, Teligent. Teligent is a publicly-owned company (NASDAQ symbol: TGNT) with a market capitalization of approximately 3.36 billion, as of April 1999. Attached hereto as Exhibit 7 is a copy of Teligent's most recent annual report.

11. Applicant also agrees that:

- A. It will file and maintain basic local exchange service tariff(s) with the Commission in the same manner and form as the Commission requires of incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which applicant will compete;
- B. It will meet the minimum basic local service standards, including quality of service and billing standards, as the Commission may require of the incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which it will compete;
- C. It will offer basic local telecommunications service as a separate and distinct service and will offer basic service within the exchange boundaries of the exchanges identified in Exhibit, unless authorized by this Commission, or any other agency having jurisdiction, to offer and provide service in areas smaller than an exchange pursuant to Section 392.200.4 RSMo. or other applicable law; and
- D. In accord with state and federal law, and with Commission rules and regulations on the issue, but without waiver of applicant's right to appear in any rulemaking proceeding or other proceeding regarding the same, Applicant will provide equitable access to subscribers within the area proposed to be served. See Section 392.455.(5), RSMo.

12. Applicant requests classification as a competitive basic local exchange and local exchange telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant further requests

classification of services described in its proposed tariff as competitive services consistent with the Telecommunications Act of 1996. Such request includes classification of exchange access services as competitive services.

13. Applicant will comply with all applicable Commission rules and regulations except those which are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to Applicant's request.

14. Applicant also respectfully requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo 1994 that the Commission suspend, waive or modify the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of the Applicant as a competitive basic exchange and local exchange company:

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

15. WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Commission grant it a Certificate of Service Authority to Provide Basic Local Exchange and Local Exchange Intrastate Telecommunications Services within the State of Missouri; an order classifying it as a competitive telecommunications company providing competitive services; an order suspending, waiving, or modifying the above-referenced rules and statutory provisions as they relate to the regulation of the Applicant in the State of Missouri; and such other orders and further relief the Commission deems appropriate.







CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

OF

TELIGENT SERVICES, INC.

FIRST: The name of the Corporation is Teligent Services, Inc. (hereinafter the "Corporation").

SECOND: The address of the registered office of the Corporation in the State of Delaware is 1209 Orange Street, in the City of Wilmington, County of New Castle. The name of its registered agent at that address is The Corporation Trust Company.

THIRD: The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under the General Corporation Law of the State of Delaware as set forth in Title 8 of the Delaware Code (the "GCL").

FOURTH: The total number of shares of stock which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is One Thousand (1,000) shares of Common Stock, each having a par value of one cent (\$0.01).

FIFTH: The name and mailing address of the Sole Incorporator is as follows:

SIXTH: The following provisions are inserted for the management of the business and the conduct of the affairs of the Corporation, and for further definition, limitation and regulation of the powers of the Corporation and of its directors and stockholders:

(1) The business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by or under the direction of the Board of Directors.

(2) The directors shall have concurrent power with the stockholders to make, alter, amend, change, add to or repeal the By-Laws of the Corporation.

(3) The number of directors of the Corporation shall be as from time to time fixed by, or in the manner provided in, the By-Laws of the Corporation. Election of directors need not be by written ballot unless the By-Laws so provide.

(4) No director shall be personally liable to the Corporation or any of its stockholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director, except for liability (i) for any breach of the director's duty of loyalty to the Corporation or its stockholders, (ii) for acts or omissions not in good faith or which involve intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law, (iii) pursuant to Section 174 of the GCL or (iv) for any transaction from which the director derived an improper personal benefit. Any repeal or modification of this Article SIXTH by the stockholders of the Corporation shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification with respect to acts or omissions occurring prior to such repeal or modification.

(5) In addition to the powers and authority hereinbefore or by statute expressly conferred upon them, the directors are hereby empowered to exercise all such powers and do all such acts and things as may be exercised or done by the Corporation, subject, nevertheless, to the provisions of the GCL, this Certificate of Incorporation, and any By-Laws adopted by the stockholders; provided, however, that no By-Laws hereafter adopted by the stockholders shall invalidate any prior act of the directors which would have been valid if such By-Laws had not been adopted.

**SEVENTH:** Meetings of stockholders may be held within or without the State of Delaware, as the By-Laws

may provide. The books of the Corporation may be kept (subject to any provision contained in the GCL) outside the State of Delaware at such place or places as may be designated from time to time by the Board of Directors or in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

**EIGHTH:** The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provision contained in this Certificate of Incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statute, and all rights conferred upon stockholders herein are granted subject to this reservation.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, being the Sole Incorporator hereinbefore named, for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the GCL, do make this Certificate, hereby declaring and certifying that this is my act and deed and the facts herein stated are true, and accordingly have hereunto set my hand this 28th day of April, 1999.

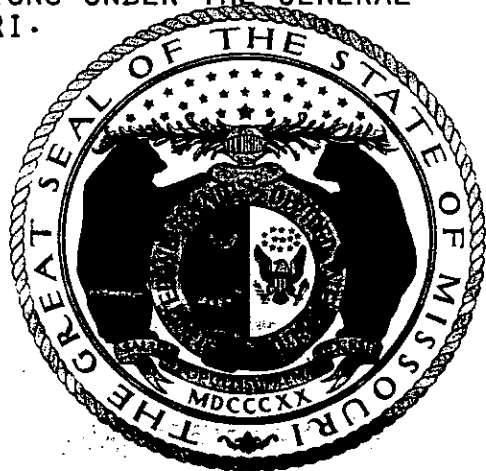

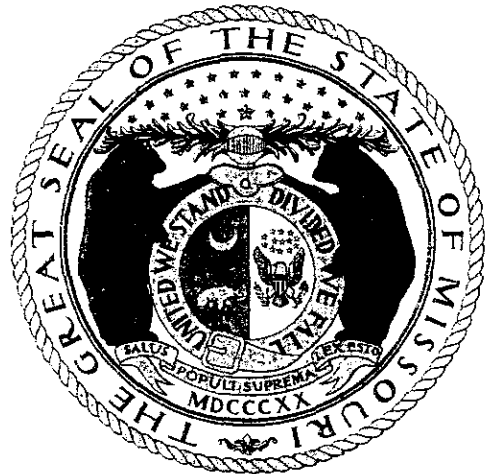

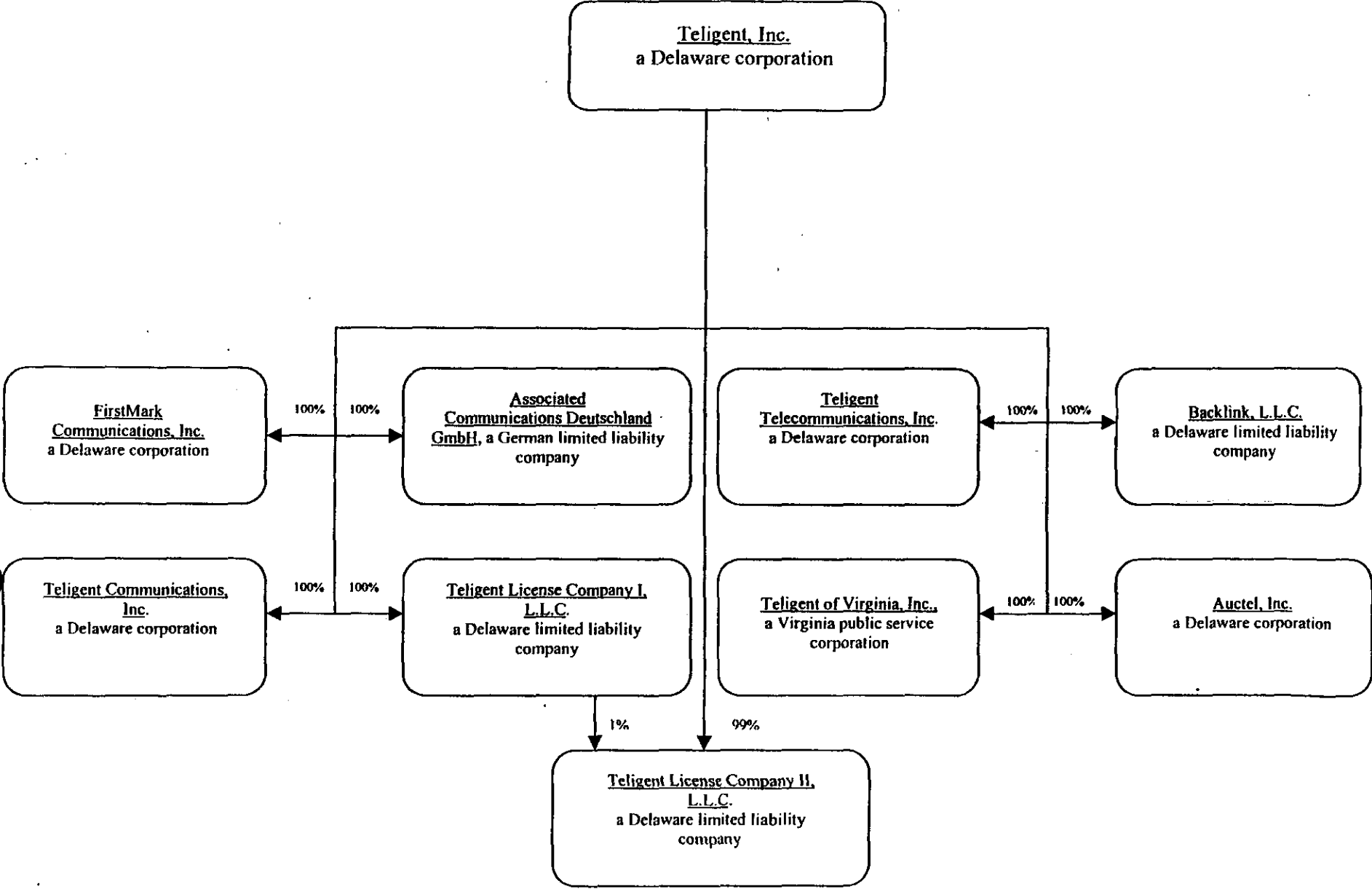
