ORDER APPROVING TARIFF

On October 15, 1999, Grand River Communications, Inc., d/b/a Grand River Long Distance (Grand River) filed proposed revisions to its P.S.C. Mo. No. 1 Tariff. The tariff revisions indicate an effective date of November 14, 1999, and are designed to add service descriptions and rates for toll directory assistance, which were inadvertently omitted from the original tariff filing. As the tariff is currently written, Grand River will not be able to bill its customers and recover its costs for toll directory assistance. Grand River will begin providing the service on October 20, and requested that the Commission expedite its consideration of the tariff.

On October 20, the Commission issued an Order Directing Staff to Expedite Consideration of Tariff. On October 20, Grand River filed a substitute sheet to correct a typographical error. Staff filed a memorandum on October 21, indicating that Staff has reviewed the tariff sheets submitted by Grand River and recommends that the Commission approve them as amended, to become effective as soon as possible.

The Commission has reviewed the tariff sheets and Staff's recommendation and finds that the tariff sheets should be approved to become effective on October 22, 1999.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That the tariff sheets filed by Grand River Communications, Inc., d/b/a Grand River Long Distance, on October 15, 1999, and assigned tariff number 200000370, are approved, as amended, to become effective on October 22, 1999. The tariff sheets approved are:

1st Revised Sheet No. 47, Cancels Original Sheet No. 47

2. That this order shall become effective on October 22, 1999.
