NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND MOTION, ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR INTERVENTION AND ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: May 29, 2013 Effective Date: May 29, 2013

The Missouri Public Service Commission is directing notice of the application and motion for expedited treatment, setting a deadline for applications to intervene, directing Staff to file a recommendation, and directing the applicant to supplement the application.

The supplement is necessary for the Commission to meet a statutory duty:

Any person seeking any order under this subsection authorizing the [transaction described in the application] shall, at the time of application for any such order, file with the commission a statement, [of] any, impact such [transaction] will have on the tax revenues of the political subdivisions in which any [assets described in the application] are located. The commission shall send a copy of all information obtained by it as to what . . . impact such [transaction] will have on the tax revenues of various political subdivisions to the county clerk of each county in which any portion of a political subdivision which will be affected by such disposition is located. [¹]

That language addresses impact on "affected" political subdivisions: those where the assets are located. Some political subdivisions may cross county lines. Hence the duty

is to send information to the clerks of counties, not where the assets are located, but

where any affected political subdivision is located.

The application does not set forth the counties in which all affected political

subdivisions are located, so the Commission will order the application supplemented.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. No later than June 5, 2013, the applicants shall file a supplement to the

application listing each county in which an affected political subdivision, as described in

the body of this order, is located.

2. Any application to intervene shall be filed no later than June 19, 2013.

3. No later than June 27, 2013, the Commission's staff shall file its

recommendation on the application.

4. The Commission's Public Information Office shall make this notice and order

available to the members of the General Assembly representing the residents of each

affected county, as described in the body of this order, and to the news media serving

those residents.

5. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
