ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING

On February 1, 1980, Lake Saint Louis Sewer Company (Applicant) filed with the Commission an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity which would authorize construction and maintenance of a sewer system for the public in an unincorporated area in St. Charles County, Missouri. The proposed service area is approximately two acres in size and lies 300 feet outside of the existing boundaries of Applicant's present certificated area. A single customer is located on this property. Said customer is a preschool center which must make arrangements for connection to a sanitary sewer system before it can open for business.

Approval of the Commission must be obtained prior to the construction and maintenance of a sewer system such as that proposed in the instant application. Authorization by the Commission shall be granted whenever after due hearing it is determined that such construction is necessary or convenient for the public service. Section 393.170, RSMo 1978. In order to make a determination on this matter, a hearing is hereby set on March 28, 1980, at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission's hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson State Office Building, Jefferson City, Missouri. Any person wishing to take part in said hearing, either in support of or in opposition to the application, shall file with the Commission an application to intervene on or before March 17, 1980.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED: 1. That the application of [Name] for a certificate of convenience and necessity in Case No. [Number] hereby set for hearing on March 28, 1938, at 10:00 a.m. in the hearing room on the tenth floor of the Jefferson Hotel, Jefferson City, Missouri.

ORDERED: 2. That all applications to intervene in the above-entitled matter shall be filed with the Commission on or before March 17, 1938.

ORDERED: 3. That this Order shall become effective on the date hereof.
