ORDER SETTING DEADLINE TO RESPOND TO APPLICATIONS TO INTERVENE AND ORDER SETTING PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On May 29, 2015¹, Ameren Transmission Company of Illinois ("ATXI") asked the Commission to either find that it does not have jurisdiction over this project or, in the alternative, asked the Commission to grant ATXI a certificate of convenience and necessity to build it. The Commission issued notice on June 2, giving potential intervenors until June 22 to request intervention. On June 12, ATXI filed a Motion for Order Schedule Prehearing Conference and to Establish Date for Response to Intervention Requests ("motion").

In the motion, ATXI explains that its project schedule is such that it is important that the Commission rule on the application no later than January, 2016. ATXI also believes that an evidentiary hearing is likely. Thus, ATXI asks the Commission to set a prehearing conference even before the deadline for intervention requests has run. Also, ATXI asks for a deadline for responses to intervention requests to be set.

The Commission will grant the motion and set a prehearing conference.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Motion for Order Schedule Prehearing Conference and to Establish Date for Response to Intervention Requests is granted.

2. Responses to intervention requests shall be filed no later than June 29, 2015.

3. The prehearing conference shall be held on July 8, 2015, beginning at 1:00 p.m., in Room 305 of the Governor Office Building, 200 Madison Street, Jefferson City, Missouri. That room is in a building that meets accessibility standards required by the Americans with Disabilities Act.
